

A Third Earth will be created one day -

Revelation 21:1 And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea.



E. The Sin of Pride

On the original pre-Adamic earth Lucifer had pride.

Pride is excessive belief in one's own abilities that interferes with the individual's recognition of the grace of God. It has been called the sin from which all others arise. Pride is also known as Vanity. It was this sin that transformed Lucifer, an anointed cherub of God, the very "seal of perfection, full of wisdom and perfect in beauty,"¹ into Satan, the devil, the father of lies, the one for whom Hell itself was created

The sin of pride is a preoccupation with self. It is thus very fitting that **the middle letter in the word is "i."** Pride is all about "me,

myself, and I." So even as the word "pride" is centered upon an "i," the sin itself is also centered upon "i".

4 things about pride, the original sin, causing the downfall of first system before man brought on scene

1) God hates pride - the world promotes it

Proverbs 6:16 These six [things] doth the LORD hate: yea, seven [are] anabomination unto him:

Proverbs 6:17 A proud look, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood,

Proverbs 6:18 An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief,

Proverbs 6:19 A false witness [that] speaketh lies, and he that soweth discord among brethren.

James 4:6 But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble.

1Peter 5:5 Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all [of you] be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble.

2) pride was the first sin

3) Pride is what keeps people from getting saved (you must humble yourself before God to get saved)

- confessing sin doing right

4) Satan was king of all the children of pride

Job 41:34 He beholdeth all high [things]: he [is] a king over all the children of pride.

Now Satan tries to imitate everything Jesus does:

fake Saviour
fake Bible(s)
fake religion - confuses

Luke 10:18 And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven.

- He fell like lightning

He is still transformed into an angel of light -

2Corinthians 11:14 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.

Jesus saw Lucifer fall from heaven as lightning.

2Peter 3:6 Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished:

- God destroys the first system.

THE 2 EARTHS: Creation and recreation

(A third earth will be created along with the new heaven - Rev. 21:1)

1) THE ORIGINAL (PRE-ADAMIC) EARTH

During the original creation there were no men on this earth, there were beings, not cave men. There were two creations. The gap theory is a fact.

3 reasons why the earth was created two times

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth

God preceded the universe and created it ex nihilo (creation out of nothing). His eternalness is evident from this verse (among others):

Deuteronomy 33:27 The eternal God [is thy] refuge, and underneath [are] the everlasting arms: and he shall thrust out the enemy from before thee; and shall say, Destroy [them].

During the original creation there were no men on this earth, there were beings, not cave men. There were two creations (the gap theory). It's a fact.

Genesis 1:2 And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness [was] upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.

- 1) God never in the Bible created anything without form and anything void. It says in Genesis that everything God created was good. God doesn't have to create anything and then wait for it to develop. Adam was created a full-grown man. The trees in the garden were also created full grown with fruit hanging on them. Adam and the trees have an apparent history. They don't have a real one (See 2)).
- 2) God created a universe, a solar system and an earth with a history they don't really have. The history was created instantly. God can give an animate object that's created an apparent history that it doesn't have. This may be hard to accept, but it can be reconciled by considering Einstein's theory of relativity, which basically states that the rate time 'moves' forward is relative to one's perspective. God's 'time clock' was not synchronized with ours until Adam was created. From that point on Bible 'time' and secular history 'time' are in sync.

Satan was created in a perfect state:

Ezekiel 28:15 Thou [wast] perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, till iniquity was found in thee.

The fifth cherub Satan was created in a perfect state. God also created the earth and the Garden of Eden in a perfect state. Man chose to rebel in the garden, hence the fall and the curse.

Lucifer was a being made up of hard substance: diamonds, rubies and jewels. He is not botanical, he is geological, a hard surface. We are soft. So when God created Adam He put him on an earth that was soft (trees, grass). The earth was not always like that. The earth before Adam and Eve under the reign of Lucifer and the sons of God was geological, the earth was one giant, beautiful jewel and the beings on it were similar.

Ezekiel 28:13 Thou hast been in Eden the garden of God; every precious stone [was] thy covering, the sardius, topaz, and the diamond, the beryl, the onyx, and the jasper, the sapphire, the emerald, and the carbuncle, and gold: the workmanship of thy tabrets and of thy pipes was prepared in thee in the day that thou wast created.

- Satan is all hard. This earth was a type of mineral based planet. God created a softer environment for man to live in.

God creating the earth without form, and 'void' doesn't match the other things God created.

'void' - to make empty, evacuate, discharge implying something there previously. Something was there in Genesis 1:1 and something happens in Genesis 1:2.

'form' - orderly arrangement

God did not create the Earth as waste, empty or in a state of decay (Isa.45:18). He is not the author of confusion (1Cor.14:33); God is the author of peace, order and law.

Isaiah 45:18 For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I [am] the LORD; and [there is] none else.

So something takes place between Genesis 1:1 and 1:2.

Job 38:1 Then the LORD answered Job out of the whirlwind, and said,

Job 38:2 Who [is] this that darkeneth counsel by words without knowledge?

Job 38:3 Gird up now thy loins like a man; for I will demand of thee, and answer thou me.

Job 38:4 Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth? declare, if thou hast understanding.

'the foundations of the earth' - Genesis 1:1

Job was not there when God laid the foundation of the earth, but the angels were! When God created the earth in Genesis 1:1, the angels were already there, witnessing the event. At the very beginning of day 1, the angels were already there, watching what the Creator was doing. This is why Genesis 1 does not mention the creation of angels. They had already been created. Job wasn't that important.

Job 38:5 Who hath laid the measures thereof, if thou knowest? or who hath stretched the line upon it?

Job 38:6 Whereupon are the foundations thereof fastened? or who laid the corner stone thereof;

Job 38:7 When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy?

There was something on this earth that sang: morning stars and sons of God.

Revelation 1:20 The mystery of the seven stars which thou sawest in my right hand, and the seven golden candlesticks. The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches: and the seven candlesticks which thou sawest are the seven churches.

The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches.

Psalms 82:6 I have said, Ye [are] gods; and all of you [are] children of the most High.

When the foundations were laid there was an angelic population on this earth. Satan and his angels rebelled against God (Isaiah 14) and sin was found in the anointed cherub (Ezekiel 28, Isaiah 14) then Satan and his angels fell and at that time the earth became void and without from and God created it again and put man on it. This was a judgment.

Genesis 1:28 And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.

'replenish' - 're' means do it again

Genesis 9:1 And God blessed Noah and his sons, and said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth.

'replenish' - it had been done once prior to the flood

3) In the original creation heaven is triangular shaped. The city of the great king is in Mount Zion (triangular shaped). The bible tells that the universe is shaped like a pyramid, with water underneath and above it. In the original creation the earth was not in the universe like it is now. The nation of Israel is also shaped like a pyramid, as it is in a sense, a prototype of the Universe.

2Peter 3:3 Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts,

2Peter 3:4 And saying, Where is the promise of his coming? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as [they were] from the beginning of the creation.

The above verse is not a reference to Noah's flood. The only other place in the Bible where the Earth was covered in waters is Genesis 1:2.

Genesis 1:2 And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness [was] upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.

'creation' - Genesis 1:1. Uniformitarianism says everything has stayed the same since the big bang. It hasn't. There was that chaotic earth that resulted from the fall of Satan and his angels.

2Peter 3:5 For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water:

Like a boat, the earth was floating. These terms denote that the planet earth was submerged and surrounded by waters ("overflowed") and at least a part of the Earth is spoken of as "standing out" of the water "and in" the water. That is, part of the Earth is protruding from the water and not simply just covered by waters on the surface.

2Peter 3:6 Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished:

'whereby the world' - some sort of organized system, the people, nations

'was' - when the earth and the heavens were first created

When the original earth was created it was standing out of the water and in the water. The water is the great deep of Genesis 1.

Lucifer's flood

God destroys the first system

Genesis 5-6 talk about a world that existed before Adam and Eve

[[2Peter 3:5]] For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water:

and people are willingly ignorant of the fact that this occurred.

There is a gap between Genesis 1:1 and 1:2. There was a world that was around then it died.

Isaiah 45:18 For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I [am] the LORD; and [there is] none else.

Genesis 1:2 And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness [was] upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.

That can't be what God created in the beginning. He created it to be inhabited and it wasn't there.

[[2Peter 3:6]] whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished:

Adam and Eve **replenished** the earth.

There were seeds already on the earth.

Then He had to separate the firmament.

*[[2Peter 3:6]] whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, **perished**:*

Ecclesiastes 1:4 [One] generation passeth away, and [another] generation cometh: but the earth abideth for ever.

The Genesis 1:1 world perished, overflowed with water.

'overflowed' - the context is **not** Noah's flood. This flood was a global cataclysm referred to as "Lucifer's Flood", so named because of God's Divine judgment on Lucifer's sin. It was a world system and an earth not in the situation it is now.

When Noah's flood happened the earth was in the center * of the Universe in the solar system in a galaxy and water came down from heaven and covered the earth. **In Lucifer's flood the earth is standing in and out of the water and then it's overflowed with water. That is done by sinking it.** That was the angelic world that perished. That's where it is

in Genesis 1:2. Satan was ruling over it (Ezekiel 28) and he falls (Isaiah 14:12-14) and the earth sinks into water.

*New Jerusalem will be located in the center of the new earth, which itself will be in the center of the Universe.

The passage of 2 Peter 3:5-7 is not a reference to Noah's flood, because who today is ignorant of Noah's flood? But many "willingly are ignorant" of this previous flood, because it speaks of things which happened before the events of the six days of Genesis.

[[2Peter 3:7]] But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men.

Our days are different from that world that was. **Noah's days didn't perish. 8 people were saved, so they couldn't have died.**

Noah's ark is a type (picture) of New Testament salvation.

The days now refer to Adam's days, Noah's days and our days – **Noah's world didn't completely perish.**

Noah's Flood

Why was the flood sent upon the world?

It was God's judgment against a sinful, wicked world. Men had murdered, angels had intermingled with men, wars had taken place. Man had even tried to reach to heaven with his tall buildings. Water was one of God's instruments of judgment against the world (others are plagues, famine, wars). The purpose of the flood was to destroy that entire human race except for those that chose to enter the Ark.

Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man [was] great in the earth, and [that] every imagination of the thoughts of his heart [was] only evil continually.

God saw the wickedness of man. This is the result of men that reject the testimony of God.

Genesis 6:6 And it repented the LORD that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart.

Genesis 6:7 And the LORD said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth; both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air; for it repenteth me that I have made them

Noah's Flood Scripture

Genesis 7:4 For yet seven days, and I will cause it to rain upon the earth forty days and forty nights; and every living substance that I have made will I destroy from off the face of the earth.

Genesis 7:6 And Noah [was] six hundred years old when the flood of waters was upon the earth.

Genesis 7:11 In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, in the second month, the seventeenth day of the month, the same day were all the fountains of the great deep broken up, and the windows of heaven were opened.

Genesis 7:24 And the waters prevailed upon the earth an hundred and fifty days.

The 40 days the rain fell are part of the 150 days the waters prevailed, so the total so far is 150 days.

Genesis 7:6 And Noah [was] six hundred years old when the flood of waters was upon the earth.

Genesis 7:11 In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, in the second month, the seventeenth day of the month, the same day were all the fountains of the great deep broken up, and the windows of heaven were opened.

Genesis 7:12 And the rain was upon the earth forty days and forty nights.

Genesis 7:13 In the selfsame day entered Noah, and Shem, and Ham, and Japheth, the sons of Noah, and Noah's wife, and the three wives of his sons with them, into the ark;

Genesis 7:21 And all flesh died that moved upon the earth, both of fowl, and of cattle, and of beast, and of every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth, and every man:

Genesis 7:22 *All in whose nostrils [was] the breath of life, of all that [was] in the dry [land], died.*

Genesis 7:24 *And the waters prevailed upon the earth an hundred and fifty days.*

Genesis 8:2 The fountains also of the deep and the windows of heaven were stopped, and the rain from heaven was restrained;

It rained for 40 days and 40 nights.

Genesis 8:3 *And the waters returned from off the earth continually: and after the end of the hundred and fifty days the waters were abated.*

Then the ark is going to float for 150 days. After 73 days they saw the mountain. They sent the birds out 40 days later.

Genesis 8:4 *And the ark rested in the seventh month, on the seventeenth day of the month, upon the mountains of Ararat.*

150 days + 74 days (the tenth [month] on the first day of the month - second month, the seventeenth day of the month)
= 224 days

At this point the tops of the mountains could be seen.

Genesis 8:5 *And the waters decreased continually until the tenth month: in the tenth [month], on the first [day] of the month, were the tops of the mountains seen.*

Genesis 8:6 *And it came to pass at the end of forty days, that Noah opened the window of the ark which he had made:*

224 days + 40 days = 264 days

Genesis 8:7 And he sent forth a raven, which went forth to and fro, until the waters were dried up from off the earth.

- After 264 days Noah sends a dove.

Genesis 8:8 Also he sent forth a dove from him, to see if the waters were abated from off the face of the ground;

Genesis 8:9 But the dove found no rest for the sole of her foot, and she returned unto him into the ark, for the waters [were] on the face of the whole earth: then he put forth his hand, and took her, and pulled her in unto him into the ark.

Genesis 8:10 And he stayed yet other seven days; and again he sent forth the dove out of the ark;

264 days + 7 days = 271 days

Genesis 8:11 And the dove came in to him in the evening; and, lo, in her mouth [was] an olive leaf pluckt off: so Noah knew that the waters were abated from off the earth.

Genesis 8:12 And he stayed yet other seven days; and sent forth the dove; which returned not again unto him any more.

271 days + 7 days = 278 days

Genesis 8:13 And it came to pass in the six hundredth and first year, in the first [month], the first [day] of the month, the waters were dried up from off the earth: and Noah removed the covering of the ark, and looked, and, behold, the face of the ground was dry.

The six hundredth and first year, in the first [month], the first [day] of the month - the six hundredth year of Noah's life, in the second month, the seventeenth day of the month

= 330 days (216391 - 216061) (1 year = 360 days) +

Genesis 8:14 And in the second month, on the seven and twentieth day of the month, was the earth dried.

Six hundredth and first year in the second month, on the seven and twentieth day of the month - Six hundredth and first year, in the first [month], the first [day] of the month = 56 days

56 days till the earth dried (Assuming Noah didn't leave the ark until the earth was fully dried (Genesis 8:14).

330 days + 56 days = 386 days

So by my calculations Noah was on the Ark 386 days.

The Flood itself lasted for 150 days. 5 months of 30 days each. In Revelation He does the same thing. God's months are 30 days long.

Noah's Ark

=====

Mt. Ararat - 16950 ft high, near the Turkish border w Russia and Iran.

Evidence - 1) ancient reports it could still be seen 13th century on.

2) modern eye witness accounts of an intact wooden structure standing at the snow line 13,000 feet up Mt. Ararat, it's dimensions agree w the Biblical description of Noah's Ark.

3) photographs showing a boat shaped structure high on the mountain taken from aircraft, the ground and satellites.

4) hand hewed beams said to have been recovered from beneath a glacier at the snowline and to have been assigned an age old enough to meet chronological age of the flood.

Questions that must be asked that parts of the ark have been found from Mt. Ararat -

- 1) What is Ararat?
- 2) Is Arrarat the same site mentioned in gen 8:4?
- 3) Are the reports of the ark all been at the same site?
- 4) How many arks have been found and where?
- 5) Do they all deal w Noah's ark of the Bible?
- 6) Are these eye witness accounts all in agreement?
- 7) Are the photographs genuine?
- 8) How did the ark get there?

No part peak was mentioned, so it hasn't been established for certain where the ark landed.

In the 13th century they claimed a Muslim sanctuary was made from the ark.

Josephus traced the ark back to the 1st century.

The remains of the ark have been said to have been seen to this day.

We can't determine for certain where Mt. Arrant is.

Frederick Parrot made the 1st ascent up the mountain in the 18th century.

In 1840-1883 an earthquake in Armenia exposed Noah's ark which had been under ice caps.

Ferdinand Navarra expedition 1955 recovered a 5ft hand hewed beam about 5 feet from beneath the glacier at about 13,500 ft. It was analyzed as 5,000 years old.

In 1969? Narvarra returned to the mount and recovered more beams. Tests on the 1955 where in agreement. The wood was thought to be white oak.

Noah's ark was announced to be found in 1883 by the Turkish gov't. Their first official announcement.

John Joseph claimed to see the ark in 1887.

Ajhi claimed to see it in 1857 - He described it as resting in a little lake. They went inside and found cages. The whole structure was covered with varnish or lacquer, no windows, 1 great doorway without a door.

1876 James Brice found a 4ft piece of wood 13,000ft up Mount Ararat.

George Hojapin claimed to see the ark in 1908 and again in 1910 resting on a huge rock. He found a row of windows and green moss covered the ark.

1916 a Russian aviator cited the ark and a Russian expedition claimed to have found the ark. All records were destroyed as usual.

<p>200 people have seen the ark on 23 different sightings. There were many contradictions.</p>

The Bible has the facts

Genesis 6:14 Make thee an ark of gopher wood; rooms shalt thou make in the ark, and shalt pitch it within and without with pitch.

Genesis 6:15 And this [is the fashion] which thou shalt make it [of]: The length of the ark [shall be] three hundred cubits, the breadth of it fifty cubits, and the height of it thirty cubits.

Genesis 6:16 A window shalt thou make to the ark, and in a cubit shalt thou finish it above; and the door of the ark shalt thou set in the side thereof; [with] lower, second, and third [stories] shalt thou make it.

The size of the ark was 450 ft long by 75 feet wide and 45 ft high. It was built to save Noah's family from the great flood that God was going to create. God destroyed all His creatures and made a covenant with Noah.

So the ark is 450 x 70 x 45 feet, 1,518,750 cubic feet. Based upon an average house (8 foot ceiling, 9000 cubic feet) this would have over 150 houses of room. Most animals are very small. There was plenty of room on the ark.

After the flood God had the ark to rest upon the mountains of Ararat.

Yes there was a Noah's ark. It landed on the mountains of Ararat.

Only the good Lord knows if it's still in existence.

I believe the Muslims in Turkey, where Mt. Ararat is located don't want the line of Isaac to take the credit for the Ark, but rather the line of Ishmael should. Thus, they don't want anyone to search for the Ark today. They even opened up an amusement park at the site they claim to be where Noah's Ark is located.

Noah's flood was a universal (not a local flood)

This was not just a local flood. That couldn't put the ark on top of a mountain.

Consider:

Genesis 7:21 And all flesh died that moved upon the earth, both of fowl, and of cattle, and of beast, and of every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth, and every man:

Genesis 7:22 All in whose nostrils [was] the breath of life, of all that [was] in the dry [land], died.

The land was full of dead bodies when Noah came off the ark.

Genesis 7:23 And every living substance was destroyed which was upon the face of the ground, both man, and cattle, and the creeping things, and the fowl of the heaven; and they were destroyed from the earth: and Noah only remained [alive], and they that [were] with him in the ark.

'All' and 'every' also indicate that this flood was not local in nature. The fact that the water covered the highest mountain also speaks of a universal flood. This means everything below the highest mountain was also covered, as water seeks its own level. Also, if the flood was only a local flood God would not have had to instruct Noah to build an ark, but rather just tell Noah to move the animals and guide the people to locations that *won't* be flooded.

A report of a Universal Flood is found in about 200 cultures.

Ancient Flood stories are found in widespread areas of the globe including America, Britain, India, China,

Tibet, Kashmir, Polynesia, Greece and Australia. Almost all races have a tradition of a major catastrophe very similar to the Genesis account! The Sumerian Epic of Gilgamesh an ancient flood story on a series of clay tablets from the library of King Ashurbanipal of Nineveh is one of the best known. Since all races descended from the sons of Noah, it should come as no surprise that they handed the same story to their children.

Moreover, In the days of Noah, the Bible says, a great flood covered earth's highest mountains and destroyed all human life that was outside the huge ark that Noah built (Genesis 7:1-24) Many have scoffed at this account. Yet *seashells are found on high mountains.* And further evidence that a flood of immense proportions occurred in the not to-distant past is the great number of fossils and carcasses deposited in icy, mucky dumps. **The Saturday Evening Post noted: "Many of these animals were perfectly fresh, whole and undamaged, and still either standing or at least kneeling upright....** Here is a really shocking-to our previous way of thinking-picture. Vast herds of enormous, well-fed beasts not specifically designed for the extreme cold, placidly feeding in sunny pastures....

Suddenly they were all killed without any visible sign of violence and before they could so much as swallow a last mouthful of food, and then *were quick-*

frozen so rapidly that every cell of their bodies is perfectly preserved. This fits in with what happened in the great Flood. The Bible describes it in these words: "All the springs of the vast watery deep were broken open and the floodgates of the heavens were opened."

The downpour "overwhelmed the earth," being accompanied no doubt by freezing winds in the Polar Regions. (Genesis 1-8; 7:11, 19) There, the temperature change would be the most rapid and drastic. Various forms of life were thus engulfed and *preserved in frozen muck*. One such may have been the mammoth that was uncovered by excavators in Siberia and that is seen in the accompanying illustration. Vegetation was still in its mouth and stomach, and its flesh was even edible when thawed out.

Lucifer's flood was more devastating and lasted longer than Noah's flood, for it destroyed even vegetation (Genesis 2:5-6), while Noah's flood did not (Genesis 8:11). This alone is clear evidence that this was not Noah's flood.

2) the earth was made totally dark

2) earth not totally dark -

Genesis 8:3 And the waters returned from off the earth continually: and after the end of the hundred and fifty days the waters were abated.

Noah's Flood

God makes a **covenant** with Man to never flood the earth

again -

[[Genesis 9:8]] And God spake unto Noah, and to his sons with him, saying,

[[Genesis 9:9]] And I, behold, I establish my covenant with you, and with your seed after you;

[[Genesis 9:10]] And with every living creature that [is] with you, of the fowl, of the cattle, and of every beast of the earth with you; from all that go out of the ark, to every beast of the earth.

The fowl, the cattle, the beast - the beast is not a black man. They say cattle, fowl is not a beast. However, the verse doesn't list 3 different classes of cattle.

[[Genesis 9:11]] And I will establish my covenant with you; neither shall all flesh be cut off any more by the waters of a flood; neither shall there any more be a flood to destroy the earth.

'covenant' - the Noaic covenant

'all flesh' - A proof text that this wasn't a local flood.

Liberals will say it was.

[[Genesis 9:12]] And God said, This [is] the token of the covenant which I make between me and you and every living creature that [is] with you, for perpetual generations:

God's end of the covenant will not be broken. God keeps His end of the covenant (promise). God will never destroy the earth by water again.

[[Genesis 9:13]] I do set my bow in the cloud, and it shall be for a token of a covenant between me and the earth.

[[Genesis 9:14]] And it shall come to pass, when I bring a cloud over the earth, that the bow shall be seen in the cloud:

'bow' - the rainbow - a picture of God's beauty, God's promises

Ezekiel 1:28 As the appearance of the bow that is in the cloud in the day of rain, so [was] the appearance of the brightness round about. This [was] the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the LORD. And when I saw [it], I fell upon my face, and I heard a voice of one that spake.

Ezekiel's vision was of a bow. This bow is in heaven -

Revelation 4:2 And immediately I was in the spirit: and, behold, a throne was set in heaven, and [one] sat on the throne.

Revelation 4:3 And he that sat was to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone: and [there was] a rainbow round about the throne, in sight like unto an emerald.

When we get to heaven we will see a rainbow around the throne of God. The earth is his footstool, so the throne must be huge.

[[Genesis 9:15]] And I will remember my covenant, which [is] between me and you and every living creature of all flesh; and the waters shall no more become a flood to destroy all flesh.

Next time He will destroy it by fire (2 Peter, Revelation 19)

[[Genesis 9:16]] And the bow shall be in the cloud; and I will look upon it, that I might remember the everlasting covenant between God and every living creature of all flesh that [is] upon the earth.

[[Genesis 9:17]] And God said unto Noah, This [is] the token of the covenant, which I have established between me and all flesh that [is] upon the earth.

Future floods

There's a flood in the tribulation. The devil uses it to try and destroy Israel -

Revelation 12:15 And the serpent cast out of his mouth water as a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away of the flood.

Daniel 9:26 And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof [shall be] with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.

Job 40:23 Behold, he drinketh up a river, [and] hasteth not: he trusteth that he can draw up Jordan into his mouth.

Christians won't be here!!

Conclusions

God has provided an Ark of salvation for each of us-the Lord Jesus Christ.

*Genesis 6:16 A window shalt thou make to the ark, and in a cubit shalt thou finish it above; and the **door** of the ark shalt thou set in the side thereof; [with] lower, second, and third [stories] shalt thou make it.*

There is only one door; just one way to board this ship of deliverance. There is only one door to salvation –

*John 10:9 I am the **door**: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.*

Genesis 6:14 Make thee an ark of **gopher wood**; **rooms** shalt thou make in the ark, and shalt **pitch** it within and without with pitch.

‘wood, pitch’ - They put pitch in it to seal it up, keep the water out. After the Ark was built, it was covered with **“pitch”**. This word is used seventy other times in the Old Testament and each time it is translated **“atonement”**. It literally means a covering. The wood alone could not keep the water out, there had to be a covering. The word **“atonement”** brings to mind the shedding of blood, **Lev. 17:11**. It is not the humanity, or the life of Jesus that saves us, it is His death and the shedding of His blood!

The ark is made of living organisms. The living must die so that others may have life. A picture of Jesus Christ, the life, who had to die so that we could live.

Gopher wood – cypress, almost indestructible, durable, will not rot. Wood is a picture of humanity in the Bible. This wood pictures the humanity of Jesus Christ. Just as those trees had to be cut down to build Noah’s Ark, Jesus had to be cut down to provide a place of sanctuary for you and me -

Isaiah 53:4 Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

Isaiah 53:5 But he [was] wounded for our transgressions, [he was] bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace [was] upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

Isaiah 53:6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.
'rooms' -

John 14:2 In my Father's house are many mansions: if [it were] not [so], I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

Genesis 6:17 And, behold, I, even I, do bring a flood of waters upon the earth, to destroy all flesh, wherein [is] the breath of life, from under heaven; [and] every thing that [is] in the earth shall die.

Genesis 6:18 But with thee will I establish my covenant; and thou shalt come into the ark, thou, and thy sons, and thy wife, and thy sons' wives with thee.

In this Scripture it can be seen that God saved those who were faithful to Him and loved Him more than everything else, and He saved them from the upcoming destruction of the Flood. In the same way, Jesus will take care of those who put their trust in Him, so that they could live forever.

Noah's name means "rest". When Noah entered the Ark, he found rest, safety and salvation. Being in the Ark saved his life; believing in Almighty God saved his soul!
